## Why Not Celebrate All Weekend?

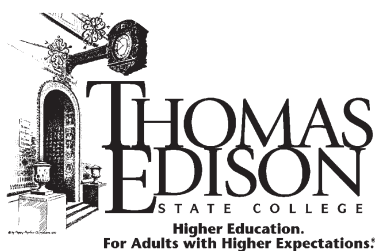
